NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS-This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Puppies in the Kem Memorial Sweepstakes must be shown by the owner, or a member of the owner's immediate family, or a member in good standing of Indiana Collie Club or Columbus Collie Club, or a member of the Collie Club of America. Rough and Smooth Collies will be shown in the same classes. Those placing 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th in each class will compete in one class for the final Sweepstakes placements and money.

THE ETHEL & GRACE DOLLENS MEMORIAL SWEEPSTAKES

The Ethel & Grace Dollens Memorial Sweepstakes is open to Collie puppies, Rough or Smooth, 6 months of age or over, and under 18 months on the day of the show, who are **ALSO** entered in a regular class at the show. Any puppy placing in the Sweepstakes and not exhibited in the regular classes, unless excused by the Show Veterinarian, will be subjected to forfeiture of awards and prizes. A RECORDING FEE of 50¢, and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes will be collected. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for junior showmanship, sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.) (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2, American Kennel Club Obedience Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 9 & Tracking Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). Rally Trial or Agility Trial will have a \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee on the first entry & \$3.00 additional entry of same dog will be required for each entry. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5 & Agility Trial Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 27) These Fees are to be collected by the Show-Giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club.

IF, BECAUSE OF RIOTS, CIVIL DISTURBANCES, OR OTHER ACTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE MANAGEMENT IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO OPEN OR TO COMPLETE THIS SHOW, NO REFUND OF ENTRY FEE WILL BE MADE.
